"Living On The Edge"

When reading the New Testament, one thing becomes evident...

The New Testament authors were living on the edge.

So, which edge are we talking about?

Jesus made the distinctions when talking to Pilate when he said, "my kingdom is not of this world."

Two worlds? There must be an **edge** somewhere between them.

Jesus told Nicodemus that unless we are <u>saved</u>, we couldn't see the Kingdom of God.

We are <u>living</u> in that **reality** – Two worlds and Two Kingdoms.

Here is a definition for you – **Faith** is the **Power** by which we are able to <u>reach</u> from the seen realm, into the unseen realm, and **retrieve** the unseen.

We can bring the unseen back into the **seen realm**.

Jesus did that!

He paid taxes with a coin from the mouth of a fish.

He healed people with mud and spit.

He <u>brought</u> the man crucified beside him into Paradise with him.

Two Realms...Two Kingdoms....Two Worlds.

Sounds spooky to those stuck in the seen realm.

That's what happened to Adam in the Garden of Eden – he was **consigned** to an existence in the Seen Realm.

Thank God that we have been delivered!
